Lake Ontario Lake Trout Tagging Study

Acoustic tags are used to study movement and habitat use.

Receivers listen for sounds made by tags and store the information each time they hear it.

Each tag produces a unique signal of sounds.

The unique sounds convey the fish's identity. Some tags also convey depth and temperature.
